Against Domestic Violence, in an amount not to exceed \$233,000 to provide services for the Community Defined Solutions to Violence Against Women Project for the period September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2012.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$233,000: 100% Federal Department of Justice grant (CFDA 16.590), no County costs.
