#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74–119–11 with Yellowstone Boys and Girls Ranch, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$109,440, to provide a day treatment program for Seriously Emotionally Disturbed (SED) adolescents, for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$54,720.
