Subject: Novation Contract #74-321-3 with Bay Area Community Resources, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee (Donna Wigand), to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74-321-3 with Bay Area Community Resources, Inc., a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$262,920, to provide school-based mental health services to Seriously Emotionally Disturbed students in West County, for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$131,460.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 62% by Federal Medi-Cal, 33% by State Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT), and 5% by West Contra Costa Unified School District (WCCUSD). There is no cost to County.

BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population in that it provides school and community based mental health services to County-designated Seriously Emotionally Disturbed (SED) elementary, middle school, and high school students within the WCCUSD,

On December 1, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74 321-2 with Bay Area Community Resources, Inc., for the period from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2010, for the provision of school-based mental health services to Seriously Emotionally Disturbed students in West County.

Approval of Novation Contract #74 321 3 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract and allows the Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2011.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, there will be fewer School-Based Mental Health Services for Severely Emotionally Disturbed Students and their Families.

CHILDREN'S IMPACT STATEMENT:

This program supports the following Board of Supervisors' community outcomes: "Children Ready For and Succeeding in School"; "Families that are Safe, Stable, and Nurturing"; and "Communities that are Safe and Provide a High Quality of Life for Children and Families".
