RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74–299-5 with Anka Behavioral Health, Inc., a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$768,900, to implement the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports Program, for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$384,450.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 53% by Federal Medi-Cal and 47% by State Mental Health Services Act (Prop 63). (Rate increased)
