Subject: Novation Contract #74-303-3 with Mental Health Consumer Concerns, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74-303-3 with Mental Health Consumer Concerns, Inc., a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$680,760 to continue implementation of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports Program, for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$340,380.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by State MHSA (Prop 63). (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing implementation of MHSA Community Services and Supports Program, including providing community-based services, personal services coordination, medication support, crisis intervention, and other mental health services to eligible adult clients in Contra Costa County.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

March 9, 2010 the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74 303-2 with Mental Health Consumer Concerns, Inc., for the period April 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, (which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2010) to provide implementation of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports Program.

Approval of Novation Contract #74-303-3 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract and allows the Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2011.
