Subject: Contract #26-506-3 with East Bay Perinatal Medical Associates

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-506-3 with East Bay Perinatal Medical Associates, a general partnership, in an amount not to exceed \$102,000, for the provision of perinatology services for Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers, for the period from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Enterprise Fund I. No rate increase.

BACKGROUND:

On January 8, 2010, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-506-1 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-506-2) with East Bay Perinatal Medical Associates, for the period from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010, for the provision of perinatology services including, but not limited to, twenty-four hour a day, seven days a week telephone consultation services for perinatal patients, on-site perinatal consultation at Pittsburg, Richmond and Martinez Clinics,
