BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

the Board approved and authorized the submission of the 2012 Head Start Continuation Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families (ACF) to continue the provision of Head Start services in Contra Costa County. The grant included the plan submitted by the County's Head Start Delegate Agency, First Baptist Church of Pittsburg, California.
