Subject: Golden Gate University Enterprise Learning Agreement

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to execute a non-exclusive, non-financial contract with Golden Gate University to provide reduced-cost University educational services to Department employees and permit mutual use of University and Office of the Sheriff names and logos in literature that promotes this program to Department employees, for the two-year period effective with contract execution and automatically renewing for an additional two years unless canceled by either party.
