BACKGROUND:

The Contra Costa County Schools Insurance Group (CCCSIG) and the Contra Costa County Risk Management Division created a joint partnership public entity in 2003. CCCSIG has provided workers' compensation medical bill review services for Risk Management at reduced annual review costs from the County's previous private provider. This contract will allow the County to continue to receive the same services. Effective October 15, 2012, the State of California has mandated a new medical bill review program required on workers' compensation claims which will require an electronic interface between the medical provider and the claims entity. CCCSIG is working with the software provider on this
