#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74–369-2 with Native American Health Center, Inc., a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$213,422, to provide Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) prevention and early intervention services for the period from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$106,711.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Proposition 63/MHSA. No County funds are required. (No rate increase)

# **BACKGROUND:**

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by conducting community-building activities, including scheduled weekly group sessions and quarterly community events for youth, adults, and elders in Richmond.

On February 8, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74-369-1 with Native American Health
