RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74–301-4 with Desarrollo Familiar, Inc., a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$207,096, to provide implementation of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports Program, for the period from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$103,548.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 32% by Federal Medi-Cal and 68% by State Mental Health Services Act (Prop 63). (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing implementation of MHSA Community Services and Supports Program, including providing community-based services, personal services coordination, medication support, crisis intervention, and other mental health services to eligible adult clients in Contra Costa County.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On January 11, 2011 the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74-301-3 with Desarrollo Familiar, Inc., for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2011, to provide implementation of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports Program.

Approval of Novation Contract #74-301-4 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract and allows the Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2012.
