<u>RECOMMENDATION(S):</u>

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-294-28 with Staff Care, Inc., a corporation, effective December 1, 2011, to amend Contract #26-294-24 (as amended by #26-294-26 abd #26-294-27) to increase the payment limit by \$400,000, from \$1,300,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,700,000, with no change in the original term of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Enterprise Fund I. (No increase in rates). Funds are coming from reduction in the Payment Limit of other locum tenens registries.

BACKGROUND:

On January 11, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-294-24 (as amended by Administrative Amendment #26-294-26 and #26-294-27) with Staff Care, Inc. for the period from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, to provide temporary physicians for Contra
