BACKGROUND:

On March 15, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-644-4 (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreement #26-644-5) with MGA Healthcare, Inc. for the period from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, for the provision of temporary pharmacy staff at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers to provide coverage during peak loads, temporary absences and emergencies.
