This agreement provides the Agriculture Department \$100 for seed law enforcement within the County.

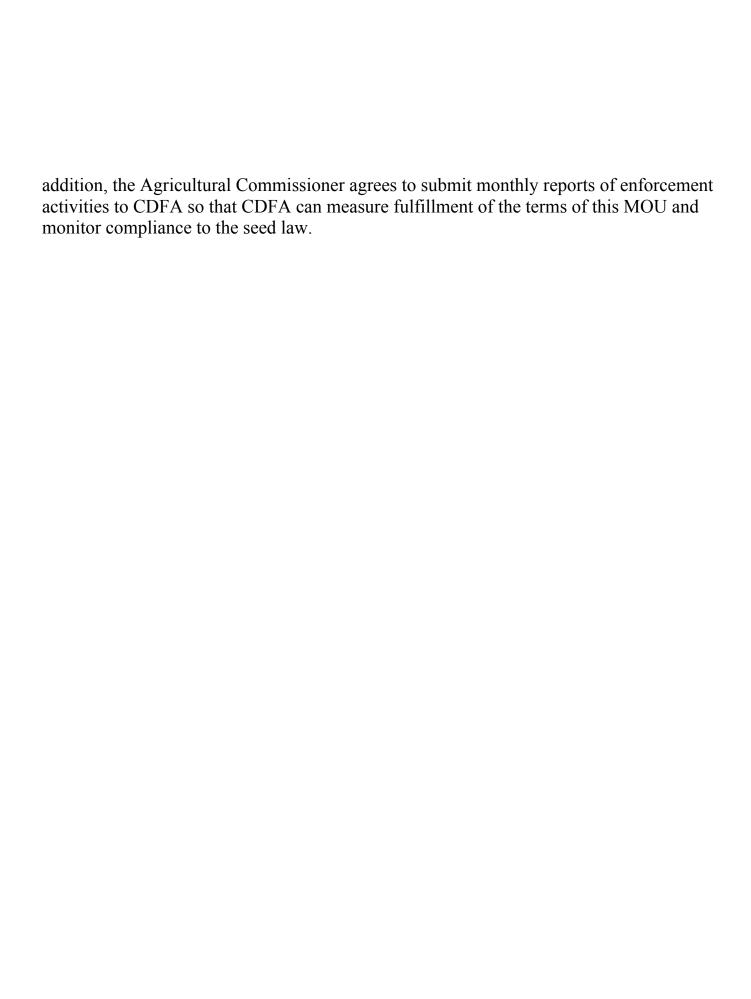
#### **BACKGROUND:**

As provided by Section 52323 of the Food and Agriculture Code (FAC), this Memorandum of Understanding establishes an annual cooperative agreement for enforcement of the California Seed Law between the Agricultural Commissioner and the California Department of Agriculture (CDFA).

Per Section 52323, the Agricultural Commissioner agrees to maintain a compliance level on all seed in the county so that the statewide compliance is not less than eighty-five percent. In
